30. Tapestry policy

All children attending The Play Den Nursery have a personal on-line Learning Journey which records photos, observations, comments and reports, in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage. This is a lovely record of your child's experiences during their time with us.

We also use the 'care diary' to record vital information about your child's personal care and to record what your child has eaten during the day.

We use Tapestry, a system which is hosted in the UK on secure servers. The benefits to yourselves from Tapestry being on-line means you will have secure access to your child's Learning Journey at any time. We encourage you to add your own observations or comments from home including photos – this can be something you have done at the weekend, photos of you reading your library books, or maybe celebrating a special occasion – anything you want to share with us.

Additionally, other relatives are able to see your child's learning journey too (subject to your permission) – ensuring they never miss out! This has proved to be an extremely popular with our families who have relatives who live outside of the UK.

When you sign a contract with us, we obtain your e-mail address and set up an account enabling you to access your child's learning journey via the secure Tapestry website for your child. (Please note you will only have access to your own child's Learning Journey).
